The Benefits of Submission


#### Philippians 2:1-8.

Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, <sup>2</sup> then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. <sup>3</sup> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. - <sup>5</sup> In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset (attitude) (1984 NIV) as Christ Jesus:
- <sup>6</sup> Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped (used to his own advantage; New NIV);
- <sup>7</sup> rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
- <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross!
