

Discussion Questions

Read the passage below and discuss it in relation to how we glorify Jesus during the Christmas season.

²⁷ "Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. ²⁸ Father, glorify your name!"

Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and will glorify it again." ²⁹ The crowd that was there and heard it said it had thundered; others said an angel had spoken to him. ³⁰ Jesus said, "This voice was for your benefit, not mine.

1. What were your Christmases like growing up? Share the good, the bad and the ugly. Were they more secular or more "religious?"
2. If you raised or are raising your family, share your struggles with celebrating Christmas in a way that was flavored with Christ. Share your triumphs and your failures.

For those who raised their kids, share with the group what you'd do differently, as a way of encouraging them to not make the mistakes you did?

If you haven't started a family yet, share your hopes for future Christmases. What are ways you can be more intentional about celebrating Christmas that is more God-glorifying?

3. Why is greeting people an important custom? It almost comes natural. No one told you to greet people, even strangers, so why do we do it?

What's your thoughts on wishing people a "Merry Christmas?"

This can be a hot topic so make sure you listen to and respect each other's perspective. Feel free to challenge or offer a different views but make sure you leave loving each other and agreeing to disagree without being disagreeable!

4. Share several Christmas traditions that are meaningful to you and why. How do they reflect the true meaning of the season?
5. If you were to list traditions that you think do not reflect the true meaning of Christmas or are a distraction from it, what would they be?
