¹¹ Greet Herodion, my fellow Jew.

Greet those in the household of Narcissus who are in the Lord.

¹² Greet Tryphena and Tryphosa, those women who work hard in the Lord.

II. Glorifying Jesus by Our Actions

You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, known and read by everyone. 2 Corinthians 3:2

It's been a long time since Linda Nelson last celebrated Christmas. She became an atheist after years of searching through the Bible and discussing it with members of the Church of Christ, a group that doesn't believe in Christmas.

"I debated myself right out of the church, Nelson said. I became an atheist because I read the Bible. Look what's in there: animal sacrifices, eating the body and the blood...yuck! If you want to celebrate Christmas that's fine with me. I work in a woman's clothing shop and we sing and play carols all the time. I've been to several holiday parties already and the name of Jesus doesn't even come up."

Nelson said one benefit of atheism is being free from the traditional holiday shopping ordeal. "I see people coming into the store with their eyes glazed over from shopping. They ask me I I have my shopping done. I tell them I don't have any Christmas shopping to do. They tell me how lucky I am!"

Be on the alert for symptoms of inner **Hope, Peace, Joy and Love**. The hearts of a great many have already been exposed to this virus and it is possible that people everywhere could come down with it in pandemic proportions. - Spontaneous singing of Carols and other music fitting the season.
- Contented feelings of connectedness.
- Frequent attacks of smiling and/or joviality.
- A sudden loss of self-centeredness.
- An increasing tendency to let go of control and allow God to be God.
- Spontaneous acts of kindness and joy spreading!
- An increased susceptibility to the love extended by others as well as the uncontrollable urge to extend it.

Some suggestions to avoid catching the virus, boost your immune system by:

- Staying away from people who believe in Jesus as Lord and Savior.
