Constancy

"for each one should carry their own load." (vs. 6)

Intimacy

"Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently..." (vs. 1)

"Restore" def. "to take a dislocated bone and put it into place."

"gently" - "But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted." (vs. 1)
