Discussion Questions

Prepare

What is a ripple effect? What do you think about CityFest and CityServe and their potential for making a lasting ripple effect in Klamath Falls and the surrounding communities?

Passage:

"Seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper." Jeremiah 29:7

- 1. Do you have a good handle on what CityFest is? What is it and what do you think about our approach to doing evangelism in Klamath County using this approach?
- 2. What models or methods of doing evangelism have you seen, used or been taught in your lifetime. What has worked and what has not?
- 3. Have you ever attended a church that you could not invite your family or friends to attend in fear that it may turn them off even further from church, Christianity, faith in Jesus?
- 4. Are you excited to invite people to the Klamath Falls CityFest or are you still apprehensive? What excites you about the festival and what concerns you?
- 5. What method of invitation best fits your personality and style? We all are different and have differing styles of sharing our faith with others.
- 6. So what is CityServe and do you think it is a good form of evangelism?
- 7. From what you heard, why should we participate in a CityServe service project?
- 8. What do you think of our focal areas: Homelessness, Youth and Family, and Clean-up & Restoration? Which area are you most excited about, which one fits you best?
- 9. What do you think of our approach to homelessness?
- 10. What do you think about our approach to serving the youth and families of the Basin?

- 11. Discuss the clear disconnect between how Christians and churches view themselves and how community leaders and organizations view the church and Christians. Have you seen this disconnect?
