Reading Plan

Notice there are several accounts of each day. If you want a full account of each day, read all the Gospels. It will be a bit repetitive because they share much in common, but each Gospel does give interesting details that the others do not, something you'd expect from eyewitnesses. Or, just read one account of each day for the sake of clarity and simplicity. As you walk with Jesus through Holy Week, both paths will reap wonderful benefits.

Sunday: Triumphal Entry

Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; John 12:12-19

Monday: Clearing the Temple

Mark 11:12-19; Luke 19:45-48

Tuesday: Jesus Teaches in the Temple

Matthew 21:18 – 26:16; Mark 11:20-14:11; Luke 20-22:6

Wednesday: Silence

Nothing is recorded as to the events of this day.

Thursday: The Last Supper, Gethsemane, & Arrest

Matthew 26:17-75; Mark 14:17-72; Luke 22: 7-65; John 13 – 18:27

Friday: Trial & Crucifixion

Matthew 27: 1-61; Mark 15:1-47; Luke 22:66 – 23:56; John 18:28 – 19:42

Saturday: Posting a Guard

Matthew 27:62-66

Sunday: Resurrection

Matthew 28:1-15; Mark 16:1-11; Luke 24:1-43; John 20:1-23
