### Discussion Questions

1. Discuss the message using the sermon outline and the notes you took. What stood out for you? What questions do you have?
2. Share a time when you were ill or going through a difficult period and were trying to figure out why you were going through it. Have well-meaning people used either of the two most commonly help explanations? Did they help or not help?
3. Job 1 tells us three things about God's relationship to evil and its cohorts (Disease, disasters, death, disappointment):
  - A. God did not author it. He did not cause pain and suffering. It was an intrusion into his perfect creation.
  - B. God is in control still restraining evil and its cohorts.
  - C. God will turn evil on its head and accomplish the opposite of evil's intent.

Which of these truths do you find most helpful in your struggle with the existence of pain and suffering in the world.... And why?

4. Describe your journey of faith and how you moved from walking by sight to walking by faith? How hard is it?
5. If you could ask God one question or to explain one situation in your life, what would you ask him or ask him to explain to you?
6. How does having Job's outlook on life (Naked I came into this world and naked I will leave it) help us face times of adversity, illness or disaster?
