And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.”

2 Corinthians 3:16-18

1. What is worship to you?
2. Share your worship experiences over the years at the churches you attended. Share the good, the bad and the ugly.
3. What do you look for in a worship service? What style or type of music helps you experience intimate moments with God? And is it all about style or are there other elements of the worship service that enables you to have an intimate moment with God?
4. What is the purpose of worship and what helps you prepare for worship so the worship time accomplishes its purpose?
5. How well are we accomplishing that purpose? What could we do better? What should we stop doing and what should we start doing? Anything you experienced at another church that would help our worship accomplish God’s purpose for it?
6. When has the worthiness of God hit you to the degree you had a Isaiah 6 moment?
7. What helps you connect with God in worship so that you experience these moments?
8. Have you ever reflected on the question as to why God desires worship and even seeks people to worship Him? What did you conclude?

9. Anything hit you about the message that you haven't talked about but you did want to mention or ask questions about?
